Karine Thate (Princeton, 1998) manages education and outreach collaborations between the Museum and NSF-funded research centers focused on nanotechnology, quantum science, and convergence technologies – including the Center for Integrated Quantum Materials, the QSTORM Research Collaborative, the Center for High-rate Nanomanufacturing, and several single-investigator NSF Career programs. Thate provides professional science communication workshops for early career researchers at multiple universities and coordinates a national network of education directors implementing science communication workshops for undergraduate research programs. She also works with researchers and graduate students to develop public presentations, inquiry-based educational activities, and community events to engage public audiences in nanoscale and quantum technologies. She was a key contributor to educational and professional development programs distributed through the NSF Nanoscale Informal Science Education Network.
